



We invite you to participate in the launch of Emory's Catalog Choice program!

Emory Mail Services has partnered with Ricoh to allow all Emory University and Emory Healthcare faculty, staff, students and alumni to establish your own personal junk mail policy, deciding for yourself what mail you do and do not want to receive. You can opt-out from receiving the junk mail, catalogs, and phone books you don't want, while still allowing those that you do want to receive.

To use, log in <u>to https://emory.catalogchoice.org/login</u> with your emory.edu or emoryhealthcare.org e-mail address. You must use your Emory address to receive free MailStop Shield service, which prevents the biggest data brokers from selling your identity to mailers. Additionally, the free MailStop Mobile iPhone app allows you to take pictures of unwanted mail and easily opt-out from receiving it.

You can create multiple aliases and multiple mailing addresses, including work and home.

Emory's paper savings will be tracked, and your profile allows you to register your unit and division so your collective environmental savings are compared against other divisions. Join us in reducing our collective paper consumption and reducing mail distribution costs!
