HOW TO GET STARTED

Q: *What is a Special Standing Student?*

A: A student admitted to enroll in individual courses for credit at the Rollins School of Public Health.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

- Official Bachelors transcript
- Resume and 3 years of full time experience
- International applicants must provide a WES evaluation of their transcript
- Approved students must complete an online orientation.

Spring 2015 - December 1, Summer 2015 - April 30

PROGRAM FORMAT:
