

Families with children ages 5-18 years can now use the Bright Horizons Back-Up Care program for:


- Homework help or scheduled 1:1 tutoring in reading, math, science, and social studies

Getting Started




First, make sure you register for the back-up care program. One back-up care use equals 4 hours of virtual tutoring.




Making a Reservation

Once you have requested a tutor:

The request is forwarded to our virtual tutoring provider



A Bright Horizons consultant sends you a follow up email within a few hours




You receive an email from our virtual tutoring provider detailing how to access your account within the next day


Once you receive your email confirmation from our virtual tutoring vendor, in this case Varsity Tutors, you can log in to your account to schedule tutoring.

Provide detail on your student, and the type of tutoring you are looking for.





You can ask questions via chat support, phone, or email


Provide additional detail on your preferred schedule and your child's learning goals.





Assigning a Tutor






- A tutor is assigned based on the details you provide
- You'll receive an email confirming the tutor assignment, a brief bio of the tutor, and confirmation of the first tutoring session scheduled
- At the end of that first session, the tutor will schedule subsequent sessions
