What is Acupuncture?

Acupuncture, one of the most popular practices of Traditional Chinese Medicine in the West, is used to prevent, diagnose and treat disease as well as to improve general health. It is a complete medical protocol focused on correcting imbalances of energy in the body. Acupuncture is used to treat a wide variety of diseases and conditions that include but are not limited to chronic and acute pain, headaches and other neurological disorders, stress and anxiety, gastrointestinal disorders, fertility and even aesthetics.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. How can patients make an appointment?

Appointments can be made by calling our scheduling team at 404-251-0096 or by submitting a referral request to the Priority Access Team using TECMD.

2. Do patients need to have a referral in order to make an appointment?

Both a physician's referral and self-referral are accepted.

3. Will the acupuncture service accept insurance?

Yes, most insurance plans will be accepted, except for Medicare, Medicaid and Tricare.

4. How much does it cost?

For self-pay patients, the initial consultation and treatment is \$189 and return visits are \$109. We will also be offering a package rate which includes the initial consultation and four return visits for \$500.

If you are using insurance, charges may vary depending on the individual plan. Contact us for more details.

5. Will patients be charged for parking?

No. Patients at Emory Pain Center will be provided with parking validation. Parking at Emory Brain Health Center is free.

6. Can patients choose either of the locations Emory Clinic offers for acupuncture?

Yes, you may now be seen at Emory Pain Center or, starting in early 2020, you may be seen at Emory Brain Health Center.
